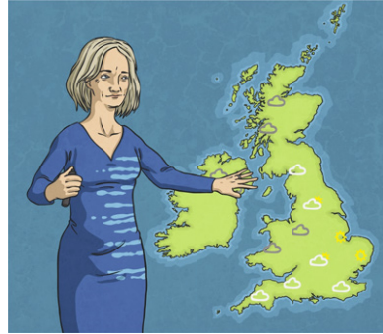

Although it was an awful idea,



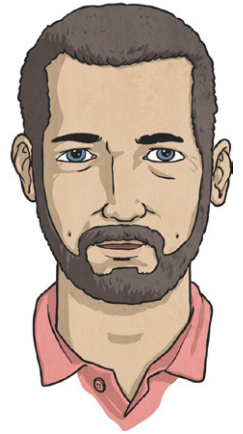
