So far, you have planned your detective agency, created characters, planned an adventure story and planned ideas for your letter. Today we will be drafting (first edition) the letter that arrives at the detective agency.

Tasks:

Remember the features of a letter, the address will go in the top right hand corner so leave enough room to write.

The letter will begin 'Dear... (name of the agency),'

- The first paragraph will introduce who you are and what you do.
- The second paragraph will explain why you are writing.
- The third paragraph will say what you want from the agency and what you will give them as a reward. Remember to use lots of detail.

Remember to make each sentence interesting, different openers, complex sentences and consider the tone you want to use - formal - so no contractions or slang, or informal where the writer is familiar with the reader.

Your task is to write your letter out in rough, ready to edit tomorrow to be used as a PROP in your film.
