

1. Writing: A diary entry

Today, I want you to write a paragraph for the question below:

1. *Can you explain 2 things that you have tried that you have never done before. It could be putting on the washing machine or baking something. What was it, how did get to do it and what were the end results/how did you feel?*

Include: 3 different pieces of punctuation, complex sentences, description.

Check: capitals and full stop, capitals for names, sense, spellings, flow.
