

1. Writing: A diary entry

- Entry number 3. You can do this in your books or on a GoogleDoc (so you can add to it daily and it will be saved). Remember to share it with me too.
- If you did it on the blog yesterday or the day before, transfer it to a GoogleDocs so you can add to it and at the end you will have a record of what you got up too during lockdown.

Today, I want you to write a paragraph for each of the questions below:

1. *Can you describe 1 thing that someone (including a pet!) in your house has done to/for you? Describe it in detail and explain how it made you feel.*
2. *Have you done something kind to people/pets in your house during lockdown? If not, what could you do and who would you like to be kind to? Describe what happened, what made you do it, what was the reaction your kind deed got and how did you feel afterwards.*

Include: 6 different pieces of punctuation, complex sentences, description.

Check: capitals and full stop, capitals for names, sense, spellings, flow.

2. Grammar task: Building cohesion (flow) in fiction

- Try one of the reasoning activities. There are 3 flavours (in the bottom corner of each page - D or E or GD).
