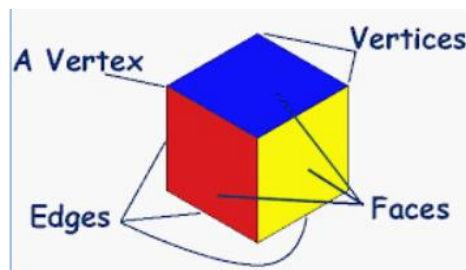
Reading – try to read for at least 10 minutes to an adult
