A free Cricket Club is starting on Thursday afternoons, for Years 3-6 only. Numbers are limited for this club, so please email the school office if you would like your child to take part.

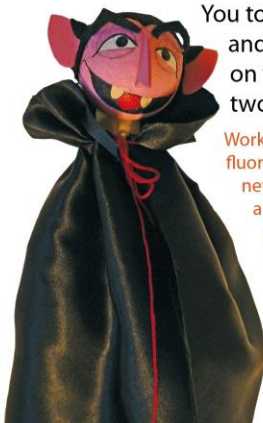

Clubs at Westwood with Iford next half term



You told us that next you'd like to make some hand puppets, and also that you'd like to do some more designing on fabric... as it's the end of term, let's combine the two workshops, and make some punk puppets!

Working on large pieces of fabric, we'll let you loose to experiment with fluorescent spray paint (non aerosol) and markers. You can then use your newly designed fabric to make your puppet (or maybe keep it to make a big summer banner or some bunting - let's just see what happens!)

With some very easy sewing and lots of cool materials, our puppets can become any character or creature you like, real or imaginary. They make especially good spooky or Tudor characters.

We plan to run workshops for: Years 3, 4, 5 & 6
On: Wednesdays (Starting 8th June) **Time:** 3.15pm to 4.30pm
We expect this activity to last for: 6 weeks (until 13th July)
We can take a maximum of: 10 pupils on each day
We need minimum: 6 pupils on each day
