Dear Parents,

We are looking forward welcoming everyone for the start of the new academic year. Term 1 starts tomorrow, **Friday 3rd September** and we are very excited to implement our new class structure.

Further to our Chair of Governors letter at the end of last term, I am pleased to confirm the following arrangements: -

WILLOW CLASS

Miss Williams and Mrs Hannam will be teaching our YR/Y1/Y2 children. They will be supported by Mrs Sage and Mrs Windo. The class will be based in what was formerly Sunflower class. Drop off and pick up point will be outside Willow Class outdoor area.

MAPLE CLASS

Mr Bennett will be teaching our Y3/Y4 children, supported by Mrs Fisher Thompson. The class will be based in what was formerly Lotus Class (so the same place!). Drop off and pick up point will be outside the Maple Class entrance facing the main playground.

OAK CLASS

Mrs Tyler will be teaching our Y5/Y6 children, supported by Miss Bartlett. The class will be based in what was formerly Clover class. Drop off and pick up will be from the main playground area.

PE DAYS

Willow Class	–	Monday and Thursday
Maple Class	–	Monday and Wednesday
Oak Class	–	Monday and Tuesday

Please could the children come to school wearing their PE kits on the relevant days.

N.B Proper PE kit is required – plain white t-shirt, plain black shorts/joggers/ school jumper/ cardigan and trainers or Black Daps.

COVID restrictions have been lifted, so face masks will no longer need to be worn in the school buildings or on school grounds, unless you wish to. We will continue with the same start time of 8.55am for all children and an end time of 3.15pm for all children.



Wrap Around Care will be available from tomorrow. Please note that on Fridays, the After School Club is for one hour and finishes at 4:15pm.

Years 3-6 will need a healthy snack for morning break.

We are fortunate to have Mr Stuart Busby, a National Leader of Education, supporting us during Mr Rockey's absence.
